ALL RACINE COUNTY BUILDINGS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC MONDAY DUE TO BLIZZARD WARNING

RACINE—Due to a Blizzard Warning issued by the National Weather Service for Racine County, Racine County Executive Ralph Malicki has announced that all county buildings will be closed to the public on Monday, March 16.

The warning indicates freezing rain and sleet will transition to heavy snowfall overnight, with snowfall rates up to 1 inch per hour and north winds gusting between 40 and 45 mph. These conditions are expected to create blizzard conditions with visibility below one-quarter mile, making travel extremely dangerous, particularly during the Monday morning commute.

The decision was made to prioritize the safety of residents and employees during the winter storm.

Essential county services, including public safety operations, will continue as scheduled. Racine County extends its appreciation to the essential employees who will continue serving the community during these severe weather conditions.

Residents are encouraged to monitor Racine County's official communication channels for updates.
